## Whatsapp video call free for iphone

For a little over a month, Android users have been able to make calls via WhatsApp, and now this feature is rolling out to iOS users. The popular cross-platform chat app is starting to make the VoIP calling feature available to iPhones, with availability making way for all iPhone users in the coming weeks. VoIP uses your Internet connection instead of a mobile service to make voice calls, similar to what Skype and FaceTime Audio do. You'll then see a list of places you can select up to seven other participants for the call. If people in the group aren't in your contacts, they won't appear in this list. Obviously, you'll be able to select everyone in the group if you have four or fewer people in the group including yourself. Then tap the blue video icon - you can also tap the phone icon if you just want a sound. When a participant receives a group video call, the incoming call screen shows the participant who is currently in the call. If you want to start by placing a one-on-one call, this bit is for you. Just open the chat with the contact you want to call, then tap Voice call (phone icon) or Video call (camera icon). Now, with group calls, WhatsApp has a special button for group calls, dubbed add participants. After making a one-on-one voice or video call, you'll see the add new participants button in the upper-right corner. Tap to add more contacts to the call. Group calls are always end-to-end encrypted, according to WhatsApp. They are also designed to work reliably in a variety of network conditions, although we will assure you you strong data signals when you make a group video call.
